Rogaining "Christmas Choice" 2018

Pre-start information

<u>Event center</u>. Event center and participant registration will be located at <u>Lielauces Folk House</u> (Lielauces tautas nams). The road from highway Biksti – Auce (P104) to event center will be marked. Event center location marked on a map (Red dot):

When you arrive at the event, please follow the traffic regulators instructions, so that you can park your car as close to the event center as possible.

Event center is a hall and utility rooms, like wardrobe, corridors, WC etc. of Lielauces Folk House. Unfortunately, there isn't showers. Places that will be enclosed with tapes or inscriptions, competitors are not allowed to stay.

Please don't walk with studded or very dirty shoes in the event center!

<u>Competition area</u>. Lielauces neighborhood. Area is mixed forest with runnability of moderate to poor areas. There is clear road and trail network. There are quite a lot of coppices in the forest. Strait and ditches are mostly overcome because the water level is low. In the forest, especially in the most dirty places, the ditches are poorly noticeable.

The lake in the center of the map (Lielauces lake) and the adjoining territory is a specially protected nature area "Vīķu purvs", marked on the map with a red thick contour. It is prohibited to stay in this area except for CP 72 and CP 51.



You are in a specially protected nature area -

in the nature reserve "Vīku purvs"!

We invite you to respect and respect the values created by nature and human beings!

Be careful about nature and do not leave household waste in the area of the competition - used carton and gel packets, drinking bottles and other household waste!

There won't be any water points placed in the area, drinking water will be available only at the event center.

<u>Maps</u>. Specially created map for this event, using LGIA LIDAR data and other cartographic information. Author of the map - Raimonds Lapiņš. Size of the map is C3 (324 x 458 mm) and Scale 1:25 000. Contour every 2m. Maps are laminated from both sides.

<u>CP values</u>. In the competition are there will be placed **42 CP** with values from **3** to **8**. Total CP value is **214**.

<u>Dangerous and forbidden places</u>. It is forbidden to cross water bodies (lakes and ponds) and insurmountable swamps in freely chosen places! The recommended crossing points are indicated on the map with a red sign)(.

It is strictly forbidden to cross the lake Lielauces and to go on the ice!

During the race traffic is not limited, so when on road, please be careful and obey traffic laws. **Be extra careful when crossing or fallowing the highway Biksti-Auce (P104)!** It is advised to use reflectors.

Crossing house yards is not allowed unless there's road going through it. Better walk around the houses, so you don't disturb the tenants. Forbidden territories – residential area, gardens, graveyards – is marked in olive green color on the map. Crossing of the territories that are agricultural or gardens is strictly forbidden. Territories that are underlined in red are forbidden. Industrial areas marked with black delineation are prohibited.

Because it's winter time and leaves has fallen from trees, the area is looking gray and everything is blending together, so it is very important to look out for tree branches and bushes. It is advised to use some kind of eye protection, for example sport googles, work googles or a cap. Please be careful and watch your eyes!

<u>ATTENTION!</u> 51KP will be placed in the area at 12:30 o'clock! Note it and do not plan to go for this CP at once after the start.

<u>Registration</u>. Participant registration takes place at event center, team registration numbers are used as identifiers. Team registration numbers can be found in the registration system. At the event center there will be list of participants.

Registration will be organized as follows:

- Team is registered, entry fee is payed and there aren't any last minute changes (green line);
- Team is registered, but entry fee hasn't been payed and there aren't any last minute changes (yellow line);
- Team isn't registered or teams with any last minute changes (red line).

After the registration participants will get the team's envelope which contains – participants' numbers, clips, rented (if any) SI-cards (cleared), SI-card wristband and food vouchers.

Participants have to attach the SI-card to their wrist with the given wristband **themselves**. Examples given in the fallowing images:





Wristbands are waterproof and it isn't allowed to cover them with any type of tape. Cord is not required! If any problems arise with the wristbands and attaching process, please talk to the judges at the event center!

Event flow. The handout of the maps will be organized outdoor, near the event center.

Only one team member with attached team number arrive to receive maps!

Team can receive the additional map for route planning.

There will be limited space for course planning indoors at the event center (desks in the dining area). It will be possible to use other available rooms in the event center. Your car can be used for course planning.

Please, after planning a course, remove your belongings in the dining area from the tables, and do not leave your property in the dining area, so that it does not interfere with the organization of catering!

The START zone of the race will be located at Lielauces Castle, about 300 m from the event center. Schedule time to get to the start in time.

At the entrance of START zone there will be placed SI-card CLEAR device.

Entrance in the start zone will be organized in multiple lines. Show the judges SI wristband mounted on the hand and make a punch in CHECK-IN device.

The participants themselves are responsible, that they have cleared and checked-in their SI-cards!

The activation of non-contact marking devices (SIACs) is provided by CHECK-IN.

KP stations will be switched on in touchless mode with a range of 30 cm (0.3 m).

The start is common to all groups according to the race center clock at 12:00 from the start zone.

SOS mobile phone number (in emergencies) +371 26517125 (has been printed on the map too)!

In case any of the checkpoint cannot be found (stolen on destroyed) or the checkpoint device isn't working, please send SMS to the SOS mobile phone number, specifying the team number, number of checkpoint from which you are coming and the number of checkpoint destroyed, for example - 2011 35,42cp (team 2011, comes from 35th CP and can't find 42th CP).

If the CP does not work, then make a punch with a mechanical punching device (composter) on the edge of the map, but You must also send SMS to the SOS number. Teams that will only show the mark with composter, but will not send SMS, CP will not be credited.

Lottery will be at the end of the race! The prizes will only be received by on-site participants.
